#### **Education and Training** with Jono

Well it's all started, new training and upgraded courses for all patrolling members. These courses are highly recommended, with trainers and assessors volunteering their time to upskill the quality of each patrol.

#### **BASIC BEACH MANAGEMENT COURSE: 7TH AND 14TH SEPTEMBER 2016**

Firstly, we need qualified Patrol Captains, and experience members prepared to undertake this course, to be mentored by our existing Patrol Captains. This will generate depth within our Patrols, and ensure sound management of the team on the beach.

The *Basic Beach Management Course* will be conducted over two Wednesday evenings at Avoca Surf Club from 6.30pm, on the 7th and 14th September. Enquiries must be endorsed by the Director of Education, Jono.

#### **EDUCATION FIELD DAY: 10TH SEPTEMBER 2016**

All trainers and assessors will complete their Education Field Day on the 10th September. A full program of Club training, and proficiency re-qualifications will be advertised following this field day.

Patrol Captains will be fully informed of all courses that are available, for their teams, and will actively encourage participation.

#### **BEACH PATROL INSPECTIONS**

The dreaded Branch Patrol Inspections, will become an easier task, with a proposed 'inter-patrol competition' being proposed, on the same guidelines as that of the Branch. A focus on Education will be placed on these inspections.

First Aid, Advanced Resuscitation, Spinal Management, radio operations, IRB Crew and Drivers are all skills that are achievable for all current members.

#### **NIPPER PARENTS: SURF RESCUE CERTIFICATE**

Nipper parents interested in competition for their child, need a Surf Rescue Certificate to complete water safety. The Surf Bronze Award, can be completed in stages, for all new members.

A current First Aid, or Radio Operations Certificate is the Basic requirement for all new members wishing to join the ranks of our current surf patrolling members.


