






SIGNAL SPOT • SIGNAL SPOT • SIGNAL SPOT

RED AND YELLOW FLAGS indicate the beach is patrolled and show the supervised area. **ALWAYS SWIM BETWEEN THE FLAGS!**



The **BLACK AND WHITE QUARTERED FLAG** indicates the area for board riding and surfing.



A **YELLOW FLAG** indicates that there are potential hazards in the water and you need to be careful. Look for yellow warning sign.



A **RED FLAG** indicates that the beach is closed and you should not enter the water.



The **RED AND WHITE QUARTERED FLAG** is for emergency evacuation - you need to leave the water immediately.


