

YOUR CLUB NEEDS YOU!!

Surf Life Saving Central Coast will be running a training course for MPIOs in the near future, with most of it being completed online.

- the car park is finished, there will be some further sweeping and rolling of the surface in coming weeks.

- the Board has been considering a range of internal changes to our **Clubhouse layout**, particularly to improve our office space, better storage, an additional toilet, cool room and access to the gym. The concept ideas and a cost plan are being firmed up and we will post the draft plan in the Clubhouse for members to view and give feedback shortly.

The plans will show a range of improvements that will form a **long term and step by step improvement plan**. There are some items that we will need to run with in the very near future but also some concepts that we will hold back on, until there is a clear need (and money available to fund them). The intention is to have a long term strategic improvement plan for our club house that can be used as guide over coming years.

- we are progressing talks with Council on **erosion protection on the bank in front of the Clubhouse**. This will be a lengthy process involving a formal planning approval process, fund raising and detailed agreements on sharing costs. We will keep you informed on how things progress.




