The Awards Of Excellence night for Surf Life Saving Central Coast was held on the 10th June and our Club was well represented with 20 members in attendance. Our Club performed very well in the two most prestigious awards:

Macs - 3rd Place in the Club of The Year!

This is a great result for our Club, third amongst the 15 Central Coast Clubs is a wonderful result. Next year we are aiming for first place. PROPOSED CLUBHOUSE RENOVATIONS

The Board has been overseeing the development of a renovation programme for our clubhouse for several months. The plans extend over 6 proposed stages covering necessary short term items and also some longer term improvements. The draft plans will be on display in the clubhouse for the next few weeks, together with a Cost Plan that provides an estimated cost for each stage.

Stages 1, 2 and 3 provide improvements to the gym, a new toilet, an improved storage area, a dedicated office and improvements to the cafe area. Stages 4, 5 and 6 are longer term contingency items. Stage 4 provides for a new cool room (our existing cool room is almost 25 years old), stages 5 and 6 provide alterations to the entry alcoves of the Club.

Subject to funding and the necessary planning approvals we are looking to progress stages 1, 2 and 3 as soon as possible. Stages 4, 5 and 6 are longer term and subject to need.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

With new members regularly joining the Club it is timely to remind each member of your responsibility to comply with the Working With Children regulations that apply in NSW.

If you have previously assessed your individual compliance requirement and registered your Working With Children number with our Registrar Denise Sherring, then you have completed your obligation. If you are new to the Club or are unsure of your compliance status then please read on.

I would expect that many members may already have Working With Children Certification as part of their day to day work activities. If you do have a work place certificate you still need to advise the Club of your details, it is not automatically portable across different organisations. Please submit your number to Denise Sherring, our Registrar.

Please consult the compliance requirements which are posted on our website. While some members engaged in Junior activities are exempt (as they have a child who is a close family member participating in nippers), other members will need to obtain certification. It is up to each member to assess their need for a Working With Children Check.

If in doubt about your exemption, then get a certificate. As a general guide you will need a Working With Children Check if, you are over 18 and:

- you are involved in training/coaching activities that involve anyone under the age of 18.
- you supervise/assist in Nippers, but do not have a child of your own involved.
- you are involved in Duke of Edinburgh programmes.

As a Board we have to ensure our Club is compliant with the legislation. See the Club's website for compliance details. Please speak to me if you have any questions.
