- Monitor stock and condition of club boards and, if necessary, arrange for repairs to be done.
- Record details of old stock which has been sold and/or damaged stock which has been disposed of or sold, and archive that information.
- Keep track of board hire on an excel spreadsheet.
- At the end of the season, organize board return, perform a stocktake and follow up those who have not returned boards.
- Reporting to Director of Competition, Craig Lee.
