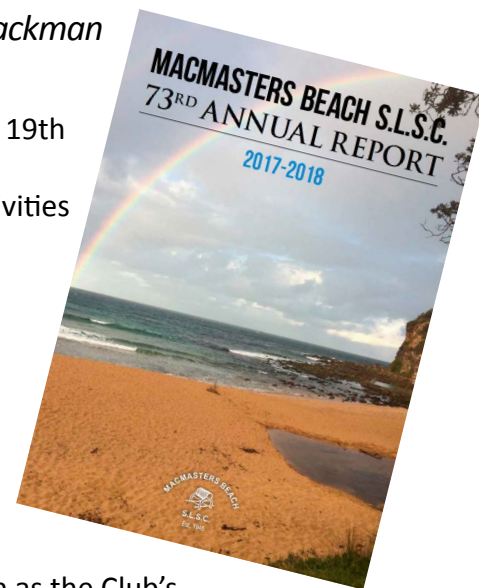
Congratulations Peter Roden, Life Member! Peter will be formally inducted at the 2018/19 Presentation Night.

An important element of the renovations has been improving the accessibility of our clubhouse with better ramp access around the building and entry into the accessible toilet.

The Board undertook a long period of consultation before finalising the design and the outcome is a credit to the input and hard work of many people.

Looking ahead, the Club will be seeking grant funding, at State and Federal level, for further improvements including battery storage for our solar roof panels and resurfacing the rear car park.

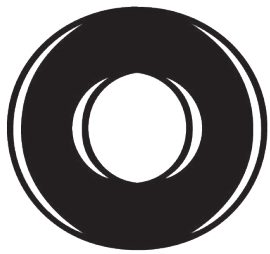

All nippers, except 6s and 7s, participating on Sundays and other members competing for our club must wear the mandatory MacMasters Beach skull cap.

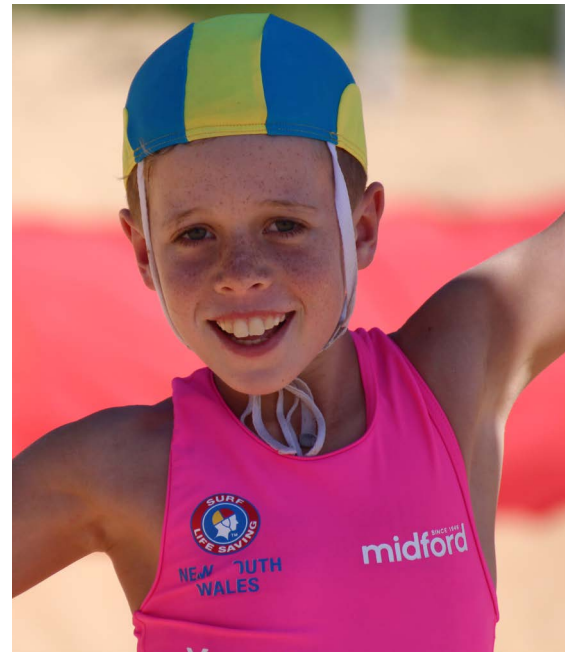

MM: Anything spicy.

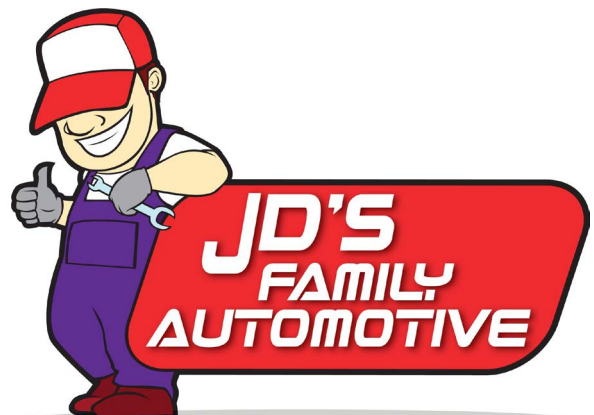
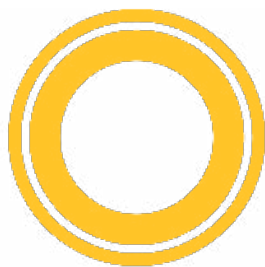
