

On Saturday the 29th of September Central Coast Rookies, from The Lakes down to Umina, came to North Avoca beach for the 'Raising of the Flags'. Over 100 Rookies, sponsored by the Newcastle Permanent Building Society, attended the ceremony.

The Raising of the Flags is where the Rookies, spectators and officials all take part in or watch the official opening of the 2018/2019 Surf Life Saving season. There are around 10,000 members in the Central Coast Surf

Life Saving Association (CCSLS) that, along with the Council lifeguards, help keep the 1.5 million locals and tourists safe on Central Coast beaches each year.

A Butchulla member from Fraser Island did the smoking ceremony and there were speeches by members of Government and the Surf Life Saving Association. We ended with photos on the beach.



### State Board Riding Championships with Anna McCall

On Saturday 8th September Molly Sheppard and Poppi Lever braved the early morning start and headed down to North Narrabeen for the state board riding championships. Competing in both the U14s and U15s the girls headed out in sloppy small conditions on the southern bank for their round 1 heat for the U14s. Both surfed well with Poppi catching some great rights and they both progressed straight through to the U14 final.

Next up was the U15s heats with the girls competing up an age group. With inconsistent waves it was anyone's day, Molly scraped through to the semi's in a heat of 5 however Pop came an unlucky third so didn't get to progress through to the next round.

With the waves becoming non existent on the south bank they moved the girls to the northern point. Although there was a bit of rain the conditions became cleaner with some nice waves coming through. Molly surfed a great U15s semi and progressed through to the U15s final.

With back to back finals Molly started out with the U15s and managed to be patient and get a couple of great waves under her belt and ended up with a silver. Staying in the water Molly was met by Poppi who paddled out for the final of the U14s. With two MacMasters girls in the finals a medal was in sight for the girls.

With mainly lefts coming through Poppi waited patiently for some rights, her preferred wave and her patience was rewarded with a nice long right, but needed another to secure a top 3 position. Molly surfed the lefts securing a couple of good turns on each wave and trying to find a barrel (didn't really pull that off) and came away with another silver.

Despite the odd drizzle of rain it was a great day on the beach and in the cafes making new friends with competitors from Thirroul, Kingscliff, Cudgen and the Northern Beaches.

Each month we will catch up with different Macs SLSC identities to find out why they are involved in our great Club and what makes them tick.


This month, let's chat with one of our Life Members, Janet Lee.
