## *President's Report continued*

### **BOARD MATTERS**

The November Board meeting made a couple of key decisions to help streamline the operation of our bar and to reduce the workload on both bar staff and the back of house team.

**Cash Out Facility to Cease:** The cash out facility over the bar will no longer be available, this will simplify the work load of the bar staff and make it much simpler to reconcile trading balances. *EFTPOS sales will still be available for all bar purchases.*

**New Membership Identification System at the Bar:** The Board has approved the introduction of a simple and easy to use technology to enable Members to access Member's Pricing when making a purchase at the bar.

A small 2cm wide paper 'dot' will be issued to members that can be stuck on the back of their existing membership card, or on their wallet or phone. Once the dot is issued it will be automatically recognised each year when a member renews their membership. This will remove the huge amount of work that has to occur each year to produce new cards and simplify the point of sale operation for bar staff.

There is a simple change that a member will need to do each time they make a bar purchase: You must scan your member 'dot' at the scanner on the bar. This will then automatically bring up the Member Price for your purchase. If you don't scan your card then the full price will apply.

Our Bar Management Team will be issuing the new 'dots' at the bar over the coming weeks and we hope to have completed the transition as soon as possible.

I thank everyone for their support and cooperation for this important change.

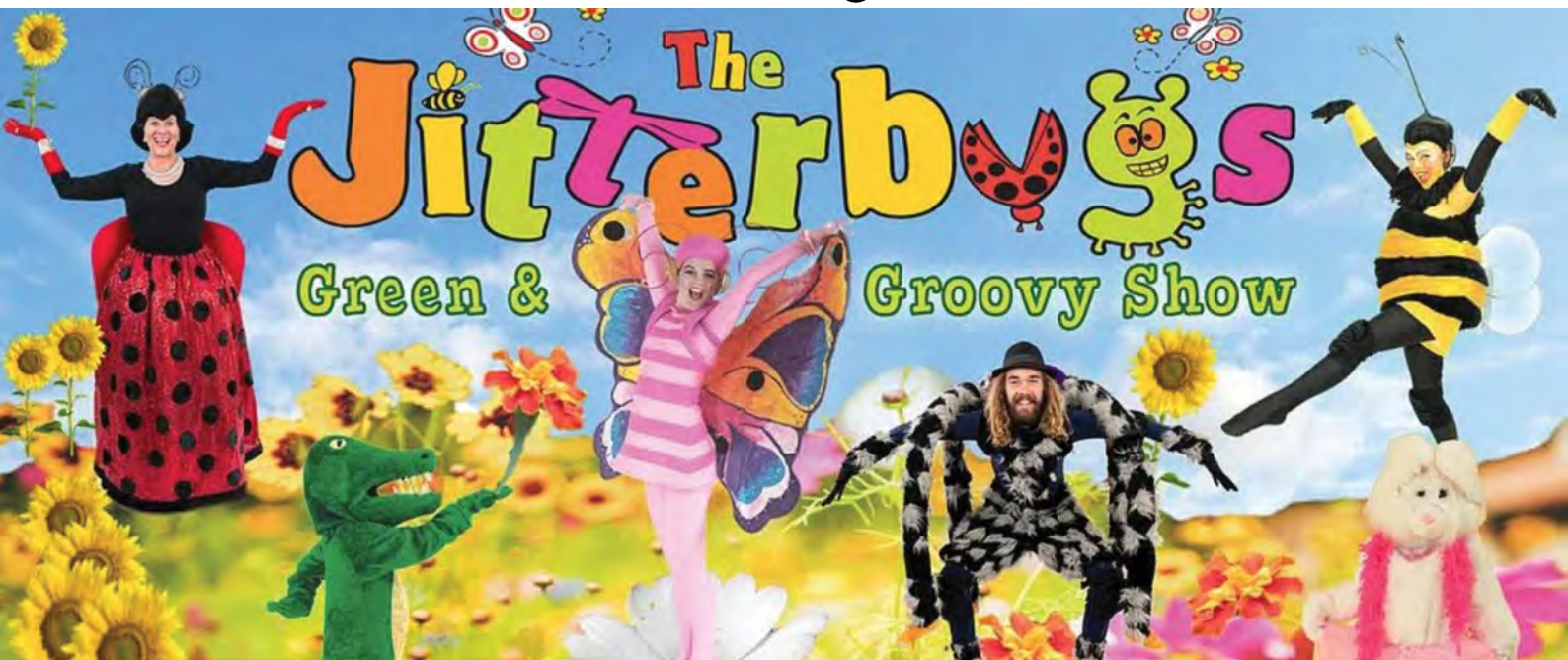

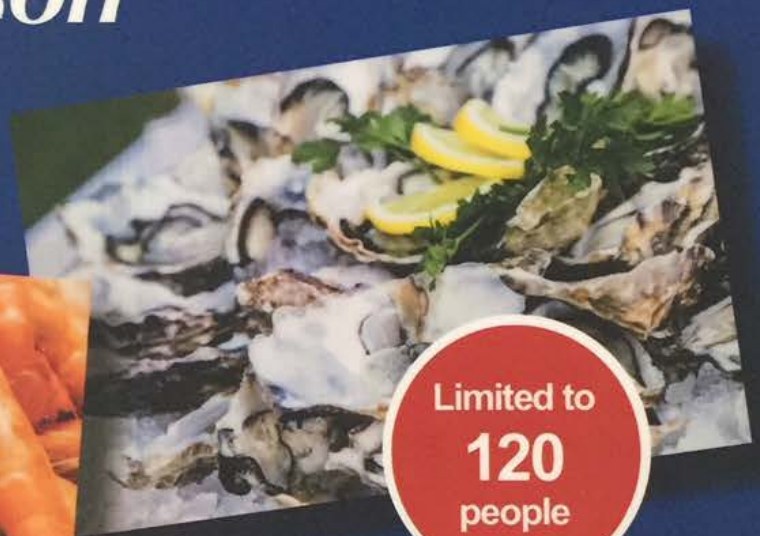

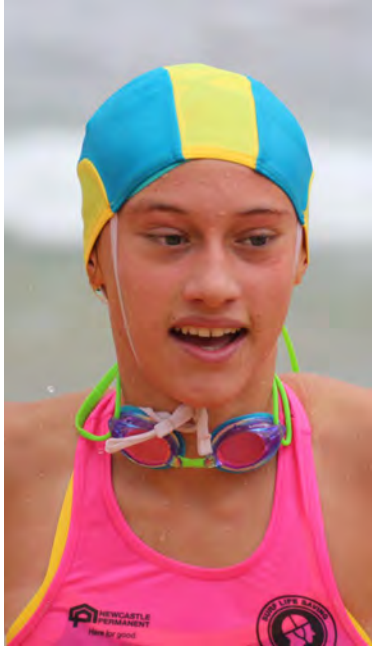


## Four Macs Nippers into Central Coast Branch Team!

# #Safeguarding Children and Young People

The role of the Code of Conduct - did you know that each year when you sign your membership form, you are agreeing to follow the [SLSA Codes of Conduct \(page 13\)](#)?

Our Club is committed to the safeguarding of children and young people in Surf Life Saving. One way we do this is by ensuring that our members behave in a way which creates a safe, positive and inclusive environment. Surf Life Saving's Codes of Conduct represent the minimum standards of member behaviour and must be complied with at all times. Both of these Codes can be found in the [SLSA Member Protection Policy](#).

Please take the time to remind yourself of what is included in the Codes of Conduct, especially the Code of Conduct for People in Positions of Authority when Dealing with Children or Young People, which has been developed recently by SLSA to support the Safeguarding Children and Young People Program being rolled-out this season.



## #Safeguarding - Child Safe Standard Number 1

**Leadership, governance and culture: Child safety is embedded in institutional leadership, governance and culture.**

- A) MacMasters Beach SLSC publicly commits to child safety and leaders champion a child safe culture.
- B) Child safety is a shared responsibility at all levels of MacMasters Beach SLSC.
- C) Risk management strategies focus on preventing, identifying and mitigating risks to children.
- D) Members and volunteers comply with a code of conduct that sets clear behavioural standards towards children.
- E) Members and volunteers understand their obligations on information sharing and record keeping.

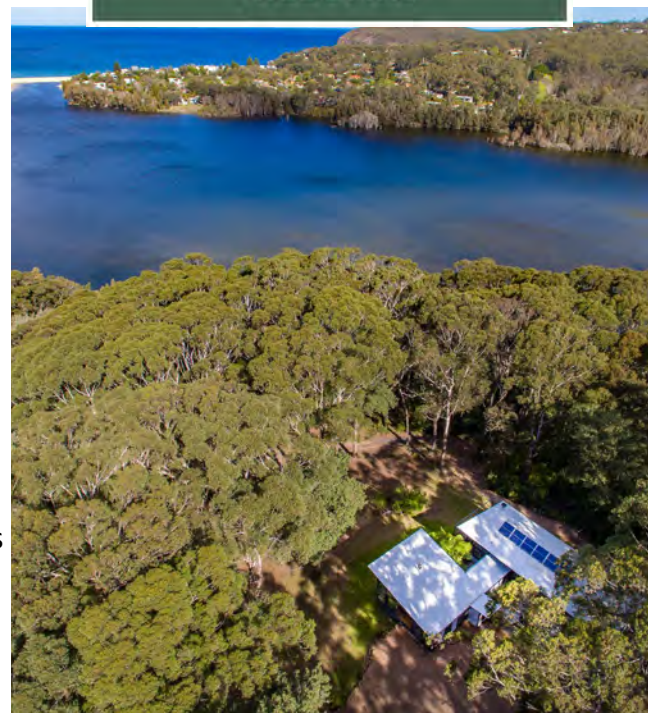
