### President's Report continued

#### **BOARD MATTERS**

The November Board meeting made a couple of key decisions to help streamline the operation of our bar and to reduce the workload on both bar staff and the back of house team.

**Cash Out Facility to Cease:** The cash out facility over the bar will no longer be available, this will simplify the work load of the bar staff and make it much simpler to reconcile trading balances. *EFTPOS sales will still be available for all bar purchases.* 

**New Membership Identification System at the Bar:** The Board has approved the introduction of a simple and easy to use technology to enable Members to access Member's Pricing when making a purchase at the bar.

A small 2cm wide paper 'dot' will be issued to members that can be stuck on the back of their existing membership card, or on their wallet or phone. Once the dot is issued it will be automatically recognised each year when a member renews their membership. This will remove the huge amount of work that has to occur each year to produce new cards and simplify the point of sale operation for bar staff.

There is a simple change that a member will need to do each time they make a bar purchase: You must scan your member 'dot' at the scanner on the bar. This will then automatically bring up the Member Price for your purchase. If you don't scan your card then the full price will apply.

Our Bar Management Team will be issuing the new 'dots' at the bar over the coming weeks and we hope to have completed the transition as soon as possible.

I thank everyone for their support and cooperation for this important change.

As a small Club we came an impressive 5th overall and brought home a swag of medals for presentation.






