ROUND 1

Round 1 was held at Terrigal in early December, with a total of 13 Macs competitors. We had Conor competing alongside his dad Frank, we had 8 out of 10 female blue and yellow caps on the line in one of the races, we had 4 female masters out of 5 competing on the day, and nearly half of our Macs crew were Masters!! Everyone had a great afternoon and managed to complete 4 board races in a decent swell.

ROUND 2

Again, the only female Masters competing on the day were from Macs! Frank and Bill had to work extremely hard in every race they went in, not getting any lucky breaks at all. Sammy and Jan completed 2 out of the 4 board races, happy that they survived the big waves. Everyone was amazing in their strength and skills in the big surf. Claire also had a go at the 'dash for cash' swim, and joined about 16 females on the same wave to bodysurf her way in to around 10th place.

ROUND 3

The final round was held at Shelly Beach on 2nd of February, and WOW, what a massive swell we all faced. All our young competitors were amazing negotiating the surf and coming back in safely over four races. Bill and Kylie were the standout Macs Masters, Bill completing four races and Kylie completing two races.

Congratulations to everyone who challenged themselves and represented Macs so well!

#Safeguarding - Child Safe Standard Number 3

Family and Community Involvement - Families and Communities are informed and involved.

- A) Families have the primary responsibility for the upbringing and development of their child and participate in decisions affecting their child.
- B) The institution engages in open, two-way communication with families and communities about its child safety approach and relevant information is accessible.
- C) Families and communities have a say in the institution's policies and practices.
- D) Families and communities are informed about the institution's operations and governance.



#Safeguarding Online Training

As we continue to raise awareness of #Safeguarding our young members at MacMasters Beach SLSC, we are encouraging everyone in the club, particularly the executive, coaches, age managers, junior activities managers and trainers, to participate in a free online training course, to remind them of their responsibilities in looking out for our young members.

#Safeguarding has been a key topic since launched at the SLSNSW State Conference in July 2018. Our club has received information on safeguarding – focusing on making a commitment and following the Codes of Conduct. The next step in our implementation is a focus on raising awareness and educating members.

The more people who are aware of the signs of abuse and what to do if they notice them, the more able our organisation is to provide an environment which protects children and young people. Surf Life Saving has two key resources to assist with this:

- 1. <u>The Online Safeguarding Training course</u>: This **free** online course takes around 20 minutes to complete and provides practical examples and scenario-based training. It aims to increase members' awareness of child abuse and child protection, and to improve their confidence to be able to take appropriate action when they become concerned for the safety of a child.
- 2. <u>The Safeguarding Guidelines</u> have been developed to complement this training by providing written information about abuse, indicators of abuse and how to report. These guidelines also includes information from the SLS Codes of Conduct as promoted in Step 2 of the Safeguarding Children & Young People roll-out.
