## President's Report with Alan Blackman

Our Annual Doorknock was another big success with around \$8,000 raised and the seafood and mal raffles have been very well supported. So many club members helped out in the running of all these activities - our members really do pitch in when needed, thank you!

February will see some big competitions coming up for our boat crews, Masters and Junior competitors. Good luck to everyone and we look forward to watching all the action!

#### JANUARY BOARD MEETING

The Board held its first meeting for 2020 on January 22nd. Our monthly meeting cover all aspects of the Club's operation and each Directors does an amazing job keeping our Club running so well. Some of the things we covered at the meeting, include:

- **Reviewing the monthly financial statement:** The Club's finances are very sound with all our revenue comfortably covering our costs - the income we receive over the summer months is critical to our financial strength.

- **Supporting our competitors:** The Board approved a funding package to help support our competitors' attendance at State and National Title. We look like having between 50 and 60 competitors at the National Titles this year - I think that is a record for our club.

- **Club Shirts for our Nippers:** These will be procured during the off season and every Nipper who signs up for the 2020/21 season will recieve a Club shirt.

#### JANUARY BOARD MEETING CONTINUED

- **Rescue, Competition and Club House Equipment:** Some of the things we acquired or have ordered include oars for the boats to replace a few broken ones, a new fridge for the bar (the old one expired), fridge and freezer for the first aid room, first aid table, sound system equipment to replace the amplifier and other equipment that shorted out during a storm and a new IRB hull.

- **Regulation Compliance:** Compliance reports have been submitted for a range of regulation requirements covering our charity status, liquor licence, Working With Children reporting, proficiency requalification for our Patrol members and membership renewals.

- New membership applications.
- Club House repairs and maintenance.

- **Insurance coverage** for members and matters of concern that have been raised by our Club to a State and National level.


#### **MEMBERSHIP RENEWALS AND REQUALIFICATION**
