President's Report with Alan Blackman

Welcome to the winter edition of Point Break. I hope everyone is well and are staying safe. **COVID-19 AND OUR CLUB**

It is good to see that some of the Covid-19 restrictions are gradually being lifted thanks to the effort of all of us over the last few months.

The Club's Board has been keeping up to date with impacts that the Government restrictions and the many memos from Surf Life Saving NSW are having on our Club's operations. We are very conscious of our responsibility to ensure we have all the necessary

protocols and equipment in place to protect our members and volunteers. All surf clubs on the Central Coast have agreed to adopt a consistent approach in implementing the necessary protocols for the return of any activities to surf clubs.

The return of activity to our club will place extra demands on our volunteers, require that we have the necessary hygiene and cleaning equipment in place and increase the administrative responsibilities of the Board members and Club Managers.

Returning patrols to the beach for the 2020/21 season is the Board's most important area of focus. The key elements that need to implemented before any activities can commence include:

- 1. A CovidSafe Plan must be prepared for any individual activity and area. For example, CovidSafe Plans will be required for activity in the training room, first aid room, patrol room etc.
- 2. A CovidSafe Plan must detail the protocols for:
- physical distancing
- limits on numbers

- hygiene practices

- signage
- registration of attendees (for contact tracing purposes)
- use and cleaning of equipment
 - cleaning requirements
- and other necessary items.
- 3. CovidSafe Plans must be submitted to the President and the Board for acceptance, and
- 4. The appointment of a Club Covid-19 Coordinator to assist in the dissemination of information and the oversite of CovidSafe protocols. The Board has asked that I take on this role, with individual Board Members and Managers taking responsibility for specific activities and areas.

COVID-19 AND OUR CLUB CONTINUED

Some limited activity has already commenced within the Training Room under Graham Johnson's guidance.

Preparing the Patrol and First Aid Rooms for the start of the next Patrol season is a high priority. Our Director of Competition is also examining what protocols need to be implemented for access to the equipment/gear storage area at the rear of the clubhouse. These areas remain closed at this point in time.

BAR AND GYM

The current Government restrictions for Bar and Gyms require full time staff and resources to be on hand to implement the complex rules and restrictions. As a Club that depends on volunteers, we do not have the ability to reopen our bar and gym at this point in time. This is a longer term goal, especially as the restrictions ease.

Yoga classes returned to the clubhouse at the end of June after the easing of Government restrictions. Both Yoga operators submitted CovidSafe Plans to the Board detailing the specific protocols and responsibilities that they must adhere to for their activities.

START OF THE 2020/21 SEASON

Surf Life Saving NSW is yet to confirm arrangements for the start of either the 2020/21 Patrol Season or Junior Activities, but all clubs are working on the basis that both these activities will recommence at the usual time towards the end of September.

While the Club will implement the necessary protocols, it is up to every member to do the right thing and follow the rules to keep yourself, your family and your fellow club members safe!

CENTRAL COAST BRANCH AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

The Central Coast Branch Awards of Excellence were live streamed as a virtual event on Saturday 6th June. Branch did a fantastic job putting a together a very polished presentation at such short notice and they had several thousand views into the event.

Congratulations to all our Club members who were nominated for awards on the night. Being nominated is a great achievement. We did not have an winners on the night, but the quality of the competition in each category shows our members are part of an elite group.

Congratulations to Umina SLSC for taking out Club of the Year - they are doing lots of great things at Umina.

GRANTS

The Club has been successful in an application under the State Government's Sports Grants Scheme. State Member for Terrigal, Adam Crouch was very pleased for our Club when he recently announced \$13,967.00 to help us install security cameras around the clubhouse and to purchase new swim buoys to assist with our training and competitions. Thank you to Adam and the State Government.

We have also been successful with a Volunteer Grant from the Federal Government. \$4,000 has been made available and will be used for equipment to support our Duke of Edinburgh programme. Thank you to Federal Member for Robertson, Lucy Wicks, for your support.


