


If you are in a position to help with the following please let Julia or myself know:

Welcome back to Macs patrols. Let's hope the water temp continues to climb and the seas are kinder to us this season. It would be great if you could tick off these boxes:

- 2. **Signals** (beach to water and water to beach)
- 3. Resuscitation DRSABCD, team CPR with rescue breaths (using a disposable mask)
- 4. Radio Pre-op check, channels, 4 P's position, problem, people, progress
- 5. Rescue board/tube
- 6. Spinal

→ Bronze practical will be assessed by an Endorsed Delegate (one of our experts, often the patrol captain). We'll also let you know about some requals run by Macs trainers Jono and Rod.
