

#### **SLSA AUSSIES CHAMPS - BOATS**

Last month saw our 3 Boat Crews compete at the Australian Titles at Alexandra Headlands in Queensland.

Due to bad weather and rough conditions our crews faced an adjusted program and in true Macs fashion didn't let it bother them with all crews putting in a strong performance both in and out of the boat. All competition had been altered to straight out elimination from Round 1 on.

The Wednesday saw us setting up the boats and tent for the competition week and having our warm ups adjusting to the tricky conditions on offer: shallow sand bars, rocks and decent surf made warm ups and racing tough.

Thursday saw the *Fat Dads* kick off competition for us, the boys put in a strong performance to make it through Round 1 and avoid the Repercharge Rows. A close finish in round 2 with 5 crews hitting the line together saw the Fat Dads eliminated from racing early and setting up in the beach bar to watch the remainder of the days racing.

Our *U19 Minis* competed Friday and due to forecast bad conditions all Junior racing was to be completed on the Friday. The girls experienced their first heavy wipeout in race 1, putting them into the Repercharge Round. The girls shook of the first round rollover to move through the Repercharge and further rounds, missing out in a close finish in the 1st Semi.

A great performance from the girls in there last season of U19s to make the Aussies Semi Final!

Our *Open Men* finally got to start racing on the Saturday. Forecast deteriorating weather and surf, meant all open racing was to be completed on Saturday instead of the usual Sunday finals. They put together there best performance of the year, making it through the early rounds and into the Quarter Final.

The Open Mens divison is as tough and fast as it has ever been and for their first year together, the crew showed true spirit and determination to fight through race after race.

**A huge thank you** to the club, our committee, sponsors and other members for your valued support. Its been another great season for the Macs Boaties and we look forward to building into next season with a few extra crews.



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## In the Macs IRB with: Tommy Gaskey


