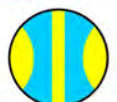

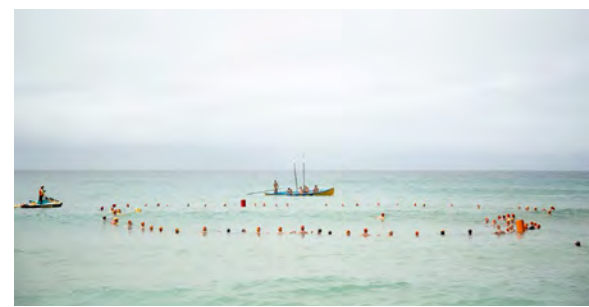
Our thanks extends to Belle Property for their amazing support. From their Bake Stall, prizes and the incredible cake to their presence on the day, they helped make the event truly special.

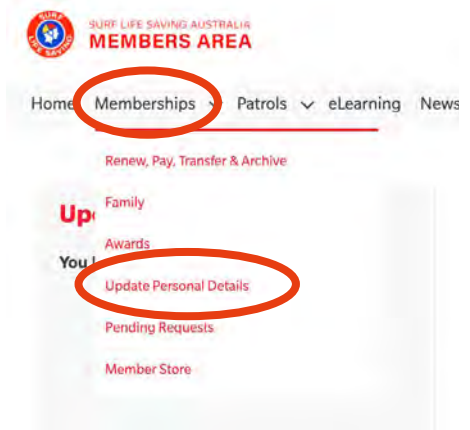

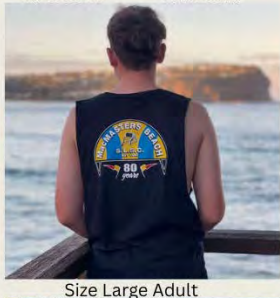
